Mureck 2 - 11 August 2022

General regulations

1. Invitation

The Styrian Chess Federation in the Austrian Chess Federation has the honour of carry out the 28th International Styrian Youth Chess Tournament U08-U18 2022 at Mureck.

2. Participation

All participants including parents, coaches, observers and relatives are obliged to stay in official hotels or guesthouses and will not be allowed to book directly their accommodation or food. All bookings must be made through the organizers.

3. Registration - Conditions of participation

*Entry forms must be sent back not later than **June 21st, 2022 by email.***

Registration must mention the surname/s, first name/s, FIDE ID number and FIDE rating of each player.

We also need the telephone number, email address of the delegation chief.

Please use the registration form enclosed.

All travel expenses and costs for board and lodging must be paid by the participants or their National Federation.

The **Registration fee of Euros 40,-** has to be paid to the Organizing Committee when registering or on arrival at Mureck.

4. Accommodation and meals

Board and lodging will be provided at Mureck or in its close surroundings.

The Organizing Committee can accommodate participants and accompanying persons in double or triple rooms or in apartments.

Board and lodging is offered to players and accompanying persons from Tuesday 2 (dinner) to Thursday 11 August (lunch).

Payments (Euros only) must be made in advance.

The cost of lodging for all players and accompanying persons for full board per day is the following:

in double and triple rooms: 60 Euros per person

in single rooms: 70 Euros per person

7. Rules and regulations

The tournament will be played according to the Swiss System in 9 rounds within two groups Open U08-U12 and Open U14-U18.

The playing time will be 90 minutes for the whole game plus 30 seconds increment per move, starting from move one.

The tiebreak will be (1) Buchholz cut -1, (2) Buchholz, (3) Sonneborn-Berger.

Default time is 10 minutes for each round.

The players cannot draw a game by agreement before black's 30th move. A claim for a draw before black's 30th move is permitted only through the arbiters in the cases of perpetual check or threefold repetition.
