General regulations

Invitation

The Styrian Association of the Austrian Chess Federation has the honour to carry out the 30th International Styrian Youth Chess Tournament U08-U18 2024 at Mureck.

Participation

All participants, including parents, coaches, observers and relatives are obliged to stay in official hotels or guesthouses and will not be allowed to book directly their accommodation or food. All bookings must be made through the organizers.

Registration and conditions of participation

Entry forms must be sent back not later than June 16th, 2024 by email.

Registration must mention the surname/s, first name/s, FIDE ID number and FIDE rating of each player. We also need the telephone number, email address of the delegation chief. Please use the registration form enclosed.

All travel expenses and costs for board and lodging must be paid by the participants or their national federation.

The **Registration fee of Euros 50,-** has to be paid to the Organizing Committee when registering or on arrival at Mureck.

Accomodation and meals

Board and lodging will be provided at Mureck or in its close surroundings.

The organizing committee can accommodate invited participants and a coach in double or triple rooms or in apartments. Free board and lodging is offered to players as well as to 1 coach per federation (if the federation nominate at least 2 players) from Friday 2 (dinner) to Saturday 10 August (lunch).

All payments (Euros only) must be made in advance until June 16th, 2024.

Category A: (as in previous years)

Overnight stay in Mureck or in its close surroundings. The organizer tries to allocate the accommodation depending on the federation so that, if possible, everyone is accommodated together. Due to the limited supply in the region, this cannot be guaranteed)

Category B: (new this year: Mureck Hostel)

The accommodation is only about 200m away from the venue.

The rooms are not luxurious but adequate. The showers are communal, but privacy is guaranteed (see the pictures)

^{*}For the first time this year we are offering two categories of rooms:

Rules and regulations

The tournament will be played according to the Swiss System in 9 rounds within two groups Open U08-U12 and Open U14-U18.

The playing time will be 90 minutes for the whole game plus 30 seconds increment per move, starting from move one.

The tiebreak will be (1) Buchholz cut -1, (2) Buchholz, (3) Sonneborn-Berger.

Default time is 15 minutes for each round.

The players cannot draw a game by agreement before black's 30th move. A claim for a draw before black's 30th move is permitted only through the arbiters in the cases of perpetual check or threefold repetition.

Prizes

The first three players the age categories U08, U10, U12, U14, U16, U18 will be awarded trophies.

A lot of special prizes are waiting for the winners
