# **General Information**

#### **Invitation**

The Styrian Association of the Austrian Chess Federation has the honour of carrying out the **31**st **International Styrian Youth Chess Tournament U08-U18 2025,** to be held in Mureck.

## **Participation**

All participants, including parents, coaches, observers and relatives are obliged to stay in official hotels or guesthouses and will not be allowed to book directly their accommodation or food. All bookings must be made through the organizers.

## Registration and participation conditions

Registration deadline: June 15, 2025 (early registration is recommended).

The registration must include:

First name(s) and surname(s), Date of birth and FIDE ID of each player Telephone number and email address of all participants (including accompanying persons).

Please use the provided registration form and submit it via email to the organizer. Travel expenses are the responsibility of the participants or their respective federations.

The registration fee of  $\in$  50 has to be paid in advance to the organizing committee. Final acceptance of registration is subject to the timely receipt of all payments.

#### Accommodation and meals

Accommodation will be provided in Mureck and the surrounding area. All payments must be made via bank transfer (in euros only), by June 15, 2025, based on the proforma invoice.

The organizers make every effort to accommodate everyone as satisfactorily as possible and as close to the venue as possible. We are aware that the accommodation situation in Mureck can be challenging and therefore kindly request that you contact us as early as possible.

If you have special requirements – such as higher standards or a preference for self-catering accommodations – please let us know. We will do our best to find a suitable option and adjust the prices accordingly.

# Rules and regulations

The tournament will be played according to the Swiss System in 9 rounds within two groups *Open U08-U12* and *Open U14-U18* 

The time control will be 90 minutes for the entire game plus 30 seconds increment per move, starting from move one.

Default time is 15 minutes for each round.

The tiebreak will be

- (1) Buchholz cut -1
- (2) Buchholz
- (3) Sonneborn-Berger
- (4) greater number of wins

The first three players of the age categories U08, U10, U12, U14, U16, U18 will be awarded trophies
